Providing and Protecting Abortion Access

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The year started with an incredible win from the Wyoming Supreme Court. In a 4-1 decision the Justices voted that abortion is health care, and women in Wyoming have the constitutional right to make their own health care decisions.

Despite this win, we anticipate that the Wyoming legislature will attempt to put a measure on the ballot; therefore, we are laying the ground work for our resistance. This year also started with more attacks from the Wyoming legislature when they passed a six-week abortion ban. For seven weeks, this harmful ban reduced our ability to provide care to people in Wyoming. We were finally granted a Temporary Restraining Order on April 24th and immediately began seeing patients at full capacity.

On June 12th, we had another win in Wyoming District Court on our 2025 lawsuit against three unconstitutional abortion restrictions. Judge Campbell in Natrona County ruled in our favor on summary judgement.

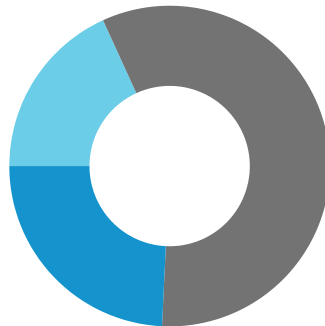
